Dear Mr. Scott:

I have been notified by the Oakland County Clerk's office that you owe outstanding fees to Oakland County in the amount of \$1,500 for failing to file or timely file the following reports: 2017 July Quarterly Statement 07/25/17, 2017 October Quarterly Statement 10/25/17, and the 2017 Annual Statement 01/31/18. You have not responded to multiple notices sent to you from the County about this matter. As the Candidate of this Committee, you are legally responsible for paying fines for failing to file or timely file the required reports.

To remedy the late reports and avoid additional fines, contact Ms. Lakenya Keyes in the Elections Division at 248-858-0563. Payments may be sent directly to the Oakland County Clerk with the reference file number listed above. If needed you may contact Ms. Keyes to discuss the possibility of paying the outstanding fees in installments.

If you do not make arrangements with the County to remedy this situation or fail to pay the Campaign Finance Violation fines within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter, I have been authorized by the County Treasurer to commence suit against you.

If I file suit I will ask for costs and attorney fees which will substantially increase the amount you owe. Likewise, the suit will be a public record and will affect your credit rating. A judgment entered in this matter could result in a lien on your property and lead to the seizure of your assets. In addition to filing a civil suit, state law provides for criminal sanctions for your failure to comply with the campaign finance law if you continue to ignore your obligation.

I urge you to contact the County to resolve this situation or mail in the payment before the thirty-day time period passes.
